New Business

1) Discuss and Select State Shoot venue for 2025. Proposal Committee (Jill, Ray and John) met June 5th by Zoom and has the following comments and recommendations:

Jill... Proposals are equal, she points out that QP wants a Regional shoot in 2026 and if they get it they would not do a State that year, so she is in favor of QP in 2025.

Ray...Also thinks the proposals are equal, is in favor of LA clays, BUT he feels that LA dropped the ball last year and they really need to do better setting the main targets (one course too soft) and FITASC.

John... Proposals are equal, QP proposes a Super Sporting event, LA does not, John favors LA for several reasons, believes that if QP goes back to back the amount of shooters will fall off,

He feels that LA can do a better job setting targets.

Ray summarized the committee feedback.

General discussion on pros and cons of both clubs

Whether puts in for regionals or not should not be a consideration for state shoot per Ray

John feels that club hosting two years in a row will cause a decrease in shooter draw

Grace feels QP getting State next year will hurt LA Clays

Kyler agrees proposals are very similar and that it should be switched off from year to year

Lee agrees

John summarized two proposals for group

Conversation on the benefits of Super Sporting that QP has proposed and if it should be in the State shoot

Tom would like to see Super Sporting as stand-alone state event

Consensus is LA Clays is overwhelmed by regular state shoot and could not add Super Sporting

Ray would like to hear from others on board and their thoughts

Lana thinks that QP may be a good State shoot warm up for Western Regional since Rock Creek has regions

Grace believes 90% of CA State shooters would not travel to regional shoot

Grace also added that State shoot should not be run on one course per day. There should be at least 2 courses running each day.

Tom believes that state shoot should rotate between north and south annually

Lana clarified that the decision for the state shoot then is turned based and not really based on who puts in

John clarified that the reason we ask for bids is to promote competition

Motion to vote on state shoot:
