After review of that form they will likely renew our Exempt status.

John discussed the State tax sistiuaction and that he has filed the opt out form 3500A, now it's a wait and see what comes back, John will file 2024 State and Federal Taxes in February,

Ron and John discussed the status on the Associations Insurance renewal.
